BONUS POINTS

- The Race Winner receives 40 points for winning the event, with second place receiving 39 points, third place receiving 38 points and so forth with points decreasing by one point per position.
- For winning the race, the Race Winner receives 5 extra points as a winner's bonus awarded towards their season point total.
- 1 point is awarded to each driver that leads a lap.
- 1 additional point is given to the driver who leads to most laps. If there's a tie in laps led, both drivers will receive the additional point.
- After the Stage Break ends on the designated lap, the Race Leader will receive 3 points for winning the Stage. The Second Place runner will receive 2 Points and Third Place will receive 1 point towards their season total.
- All Drivers and Car Owners will earn Race Points towards their season total for showing up to each event. The Driver's will only earn Race Points for the Modified He/She started the race in, a driver can not receive points for two separate Modifieds in a event. The Car Owner's will receive Race Points based upon the Driver that starts their Modified at the beginning of the race.
- The Stage Winner, Race Winner, Laps Led & Most Laps Led Bonus Points are awarded after the event and the Bonus Points are added to the Driver's Race Points to give them a combined total points for the event.

- After the race at Dominion, the Season Points are added up by a Series Official then deemed correct and official by the Series President.
- Once the Points are official, only the Top 5 in Regular Season Standings will advance to contend for the Season Championship in the final three races.
- The Top 5 in Points will compete for the championship in 3 rounds knockout style. The first round will be held at Lonesome Pine, after the event 5th place will be eliminated from contention. The second round will be held at Little Rock, after the event 4th place will be eliminated from contention and the SMART 3 will be finalized heading into the season finale. **If any of the drivers that's in the playoffs wins in the first two rounds will be automatically locked in to the season finale at North Wilkesboro.**
- At the season finale race at North Wilkesboro, the SMART 3 will battle it out to determine a champion. The **highest finishing** driver of the SMART 3 will be crowned the 2024 SMART Modified Tour Champion.
- The last three races are set races to determine the champion. No additional races will be added to the schedule. The only way this can change is if a race during the season is postponed and rescheduled for a later date.
- In case of any Tiebreakers, the first deciding factor is Most Wins on the season. If the drivers are still tied, the second Tiebreaker is determined by Most Second Place Finishes. The third tiebreaker (if needed) is determined by most third place finishes.
- The SMART Tour Points System will be utilized for the entire race season and will be used to determine the final points position for 6th place on back.
